2017 Livestock and poultry industry performance*

Value of Agricultural production (at current prices Jan-June) 2017 amounted to **Php 829.97B**; higher by 10.12% from same period in 2016 at Php 753.70B;

Livestock sector gross @ Php 137B in 2017 (+10.95% higher than 2016 at Php 123B)



Growth rate in agriculture, 2016 vs 2017- 1st Half (volume of production)

- Agriculture grew by 5.71 % in 1st Half 2017.
 - Production of agricultural crops has a growth rate of 9.81%
 - Fisheries subsector's output has gone down by -0.98% growth (2016-2017)
 - Over-all livestock production increased by 0.88% with Hog production increased by 1.04% in 1H2016 vs.1H2017;
 - Over-all Poultry production grew by 5.09 % with chicken production at -5.38% increase in the same period.

Volume of Production, hogs vs chicken



Though with only 1.04% in volume of production in hogs, value of production increase by 12% due to increase in hog prices




Phil. hog inventory, 2016-2017



Phil. Sow inventory, 2017



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Hog Prices, as of July 2017







Concerns

- In the first semester of 2017, there was a short fall of supply thus increasing hog prices because last year's farm (hogs) inventory changed only by 1.38%
- Diseases are still prevalent in pig-dense areas like Northern Luzon up until 2Q of 2017 (PED, PRRS, APP)
 - Toxins in feeds that contribute to health challenges
- Need government support especially in diagnostic and disease control
