




Al in the Philippines

- Al in swine started in 1930s.
- However, the application of the technique began only in 1954 through the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI).



Al in the Philippines

- Tremendously improvement in the effectiveness and efficiency of the AI technology as a tool in swine production in the Philippines due to studies by:
- National Artificial Breeding Center (NABC)
- University of the Philippines Los Banos (UPLB), and
- innovations made by the International Training Center for Pig Husbandry (ITCPH) and some private institutions
- Accelerated adoption of AI technology as a significant development in the local swine industry.

For Paternal Lines/Terminal Boars: Duroc Jersey Pietrain Duroc







Either gloved or bare hands







Microscopic evaluation

- Senior boars 1x every 3 months






Semen extension

Delivery of Boar semen

- Al technician buys from an Al center and delivers it to the sow/gilt
- Farmer buys directly from the AI center and does the insemination to his sows/gilts
