



Common Breed of Pig Common commercial crosses (DVS Malaysia, 1986)



#### Sign of Heat Detection

Heat Sign	Too Early	In Time	Too Late
Vulva	Heavily swollen, dark in red, red in colour, no or few slime secretion	Less swollen, less red in colour, slime secretion	Not swollen anymore, normal in colour and slime is sticky
Reflex	Female stays if the herd man is pushing the sides, it does not stay properly.	Female stays clearly for the herd man and show remarkable moving of its ears	Female does not stay for the herd man anymore but still allow boar to climb
Behaviour	Female is restless and climb on another female	Female is quiet, is climbing by another female and stay	No signs of climbing on other pigs

## Importing Protocol for Live Pigs

- Import Permit
  - Valid import permit from Malaysian Quarantine and Inspection Services Malaysia (MAQIS) concerning importation of such animals into Malaysia
- Description of Animal
  - · Certificate containing full description or identification of the animals
- Veterinary Certification
  - Issued by Government Veterinary Authority of the exporting country
  - Animals originate from farm or premise free from FMD, CSF, etc diseases
  - Animals clinically healthy and free from any symptoms of infectious or contagious disease at the time of export
  - Animals treated with products registered for use against internal and external parasites within 7 days prior to export

# Importing Protocol for Live Pigs

- Transportation and Landing Place
  - Swine or animals not of similar health status, animal feed or fodder shall not allow to be taken on the transportation to Malaysia
  - Consignment of animals shall be carried by truck or ship or aircraft direct to the prescribed place or landing place
- Inspection at the point of Entry in Malaysia
  - Official documents surrendered to MAQIS for veterinary inspection and verification
- Quarantine a period not less than 14 days at the approved quarantine facility
