

TECHNICAL TRAINING INPUT OF PIG REPRODUCTION IN LOCAL AND INTERNATIONAL FARMERS AT PHILIPPINE ITCPH

ITCPH (International Training Center on Pig Husbandry) is the only training center in Asia specializing on pig husbandry. ITCPH was established in 1985 as a foreign-assisted project of the government of Netherlands. ITCPH is now one of the 17 training centers of the Agricultural Training Institute (ATI) whose mother agency is the Department of Agriculture. ITCPH is a government-training center dedicated to the empowerment of our clientele to enable them to achieve their goals of productivity and profitability. Our clientele includes (non) government extension workers, farmers, entrepreneurs, private extension service providers, agricultural teachers and professors, members of rural-based organizations and cooperatives, and interested private individuals. National Trainors' Course on Pig Husbandry is one of the regular courses of ATI-ITCPH offered once a year. It is a course for extension workers / technicians of government and non-government organizations; and teachers / instructors of agricultural colleges and universities, handling pig husbandry subjects and / or in-charge of pig farm project in the campus. ITCPH provides classroom instructions coupled with practical classes, following the principle of "learning by doing" thru hands-on training; has intensive guidance by highly competent technical staff whose local and international trainings include both large and small-scale pig farming practices; and is well-equipped with facilities modest accommodations at the ATI-ITCPH Dormitory and Guest House.
