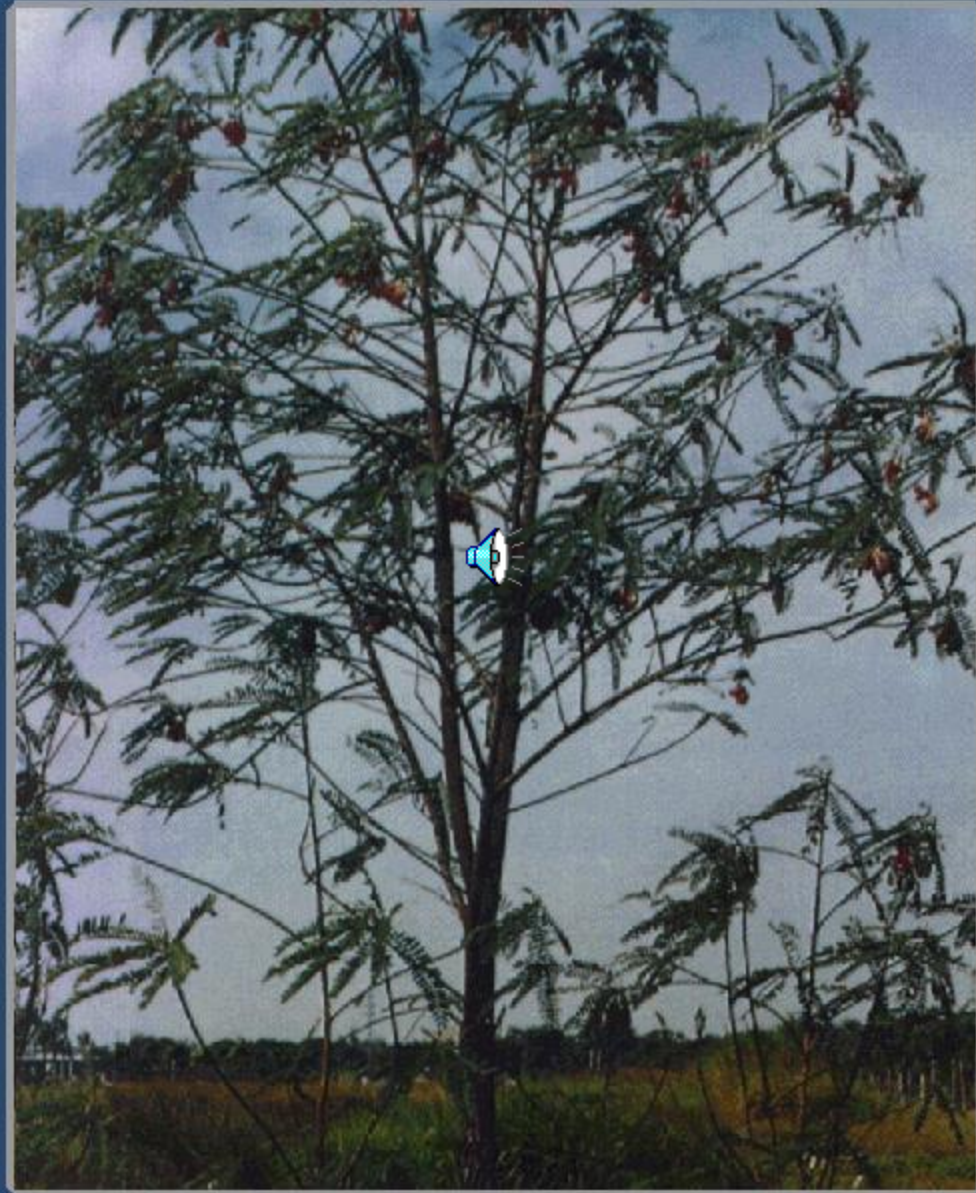
Large-flowered sesban, *Sesbania grandiflora*

Perennial, erect, trifoliate and deep tap root herb

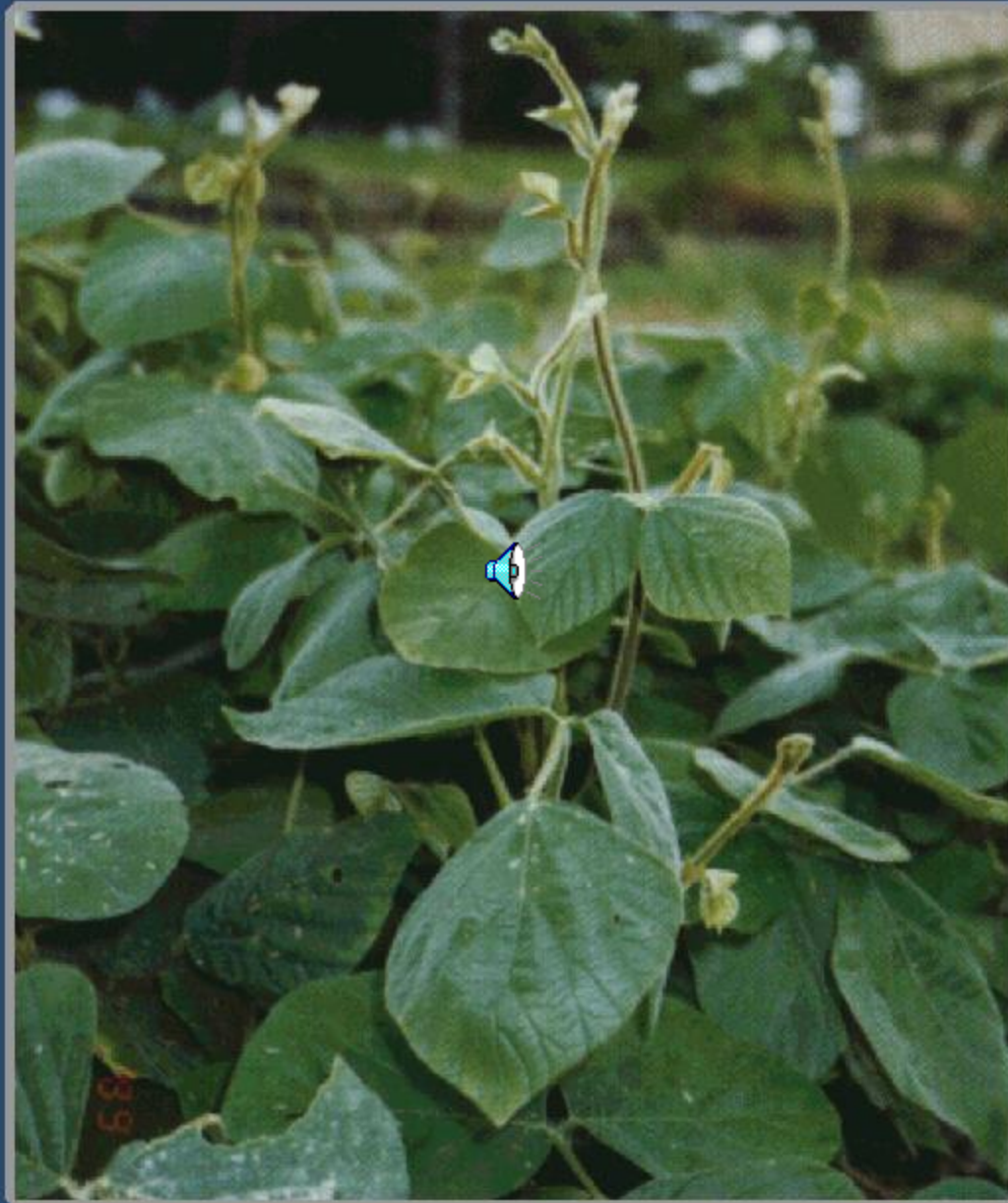

Small and brown seed.

Annual and erect stem.

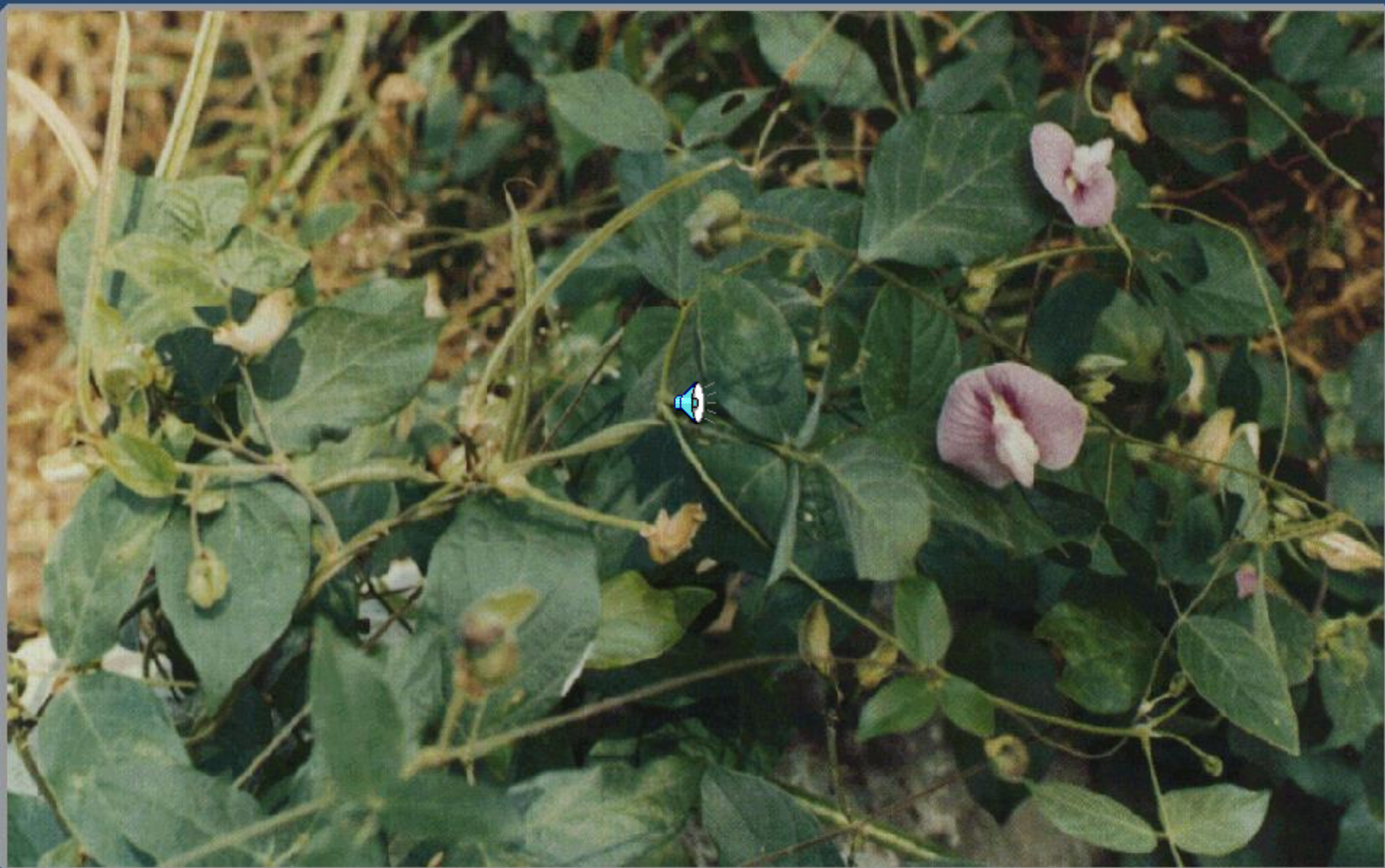
Flowers grow in axillary racemes.

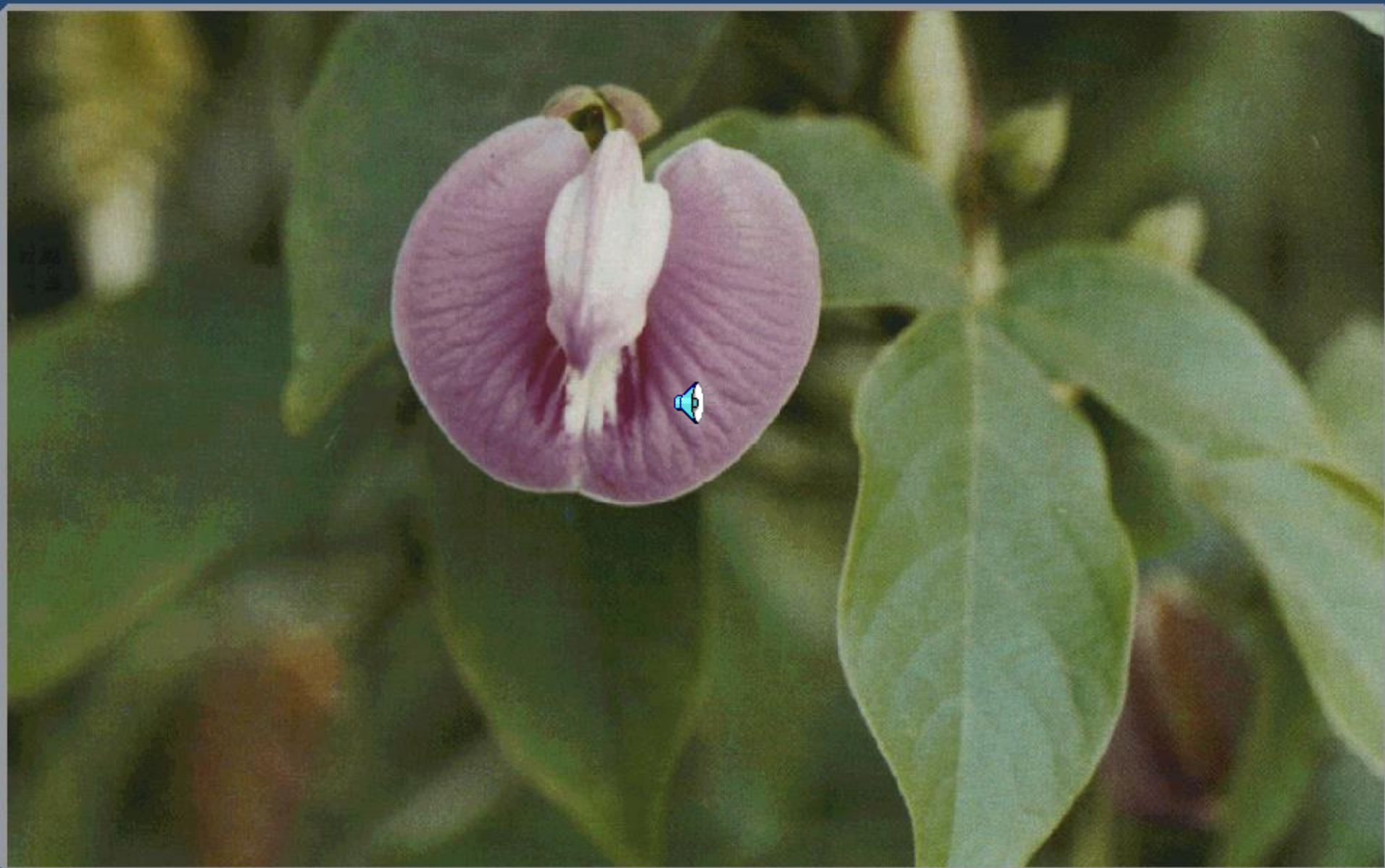
Single leaf, mature pods easily broken.

Perennial twinning vine and trifoliate leaves.

Perennial, twinning vines, pubescent dark-purple flowers.

Pod narrow and 7-8 cm long. Mature seeds spring out of pod.

Perennial, erect trifoliolate herb.

Perennial and 1-2 m high erect grass.

Small, readily shedding and strongly self-seeding seeds.

Perennial, 3-4 m high erect, high yield and drought resistant.

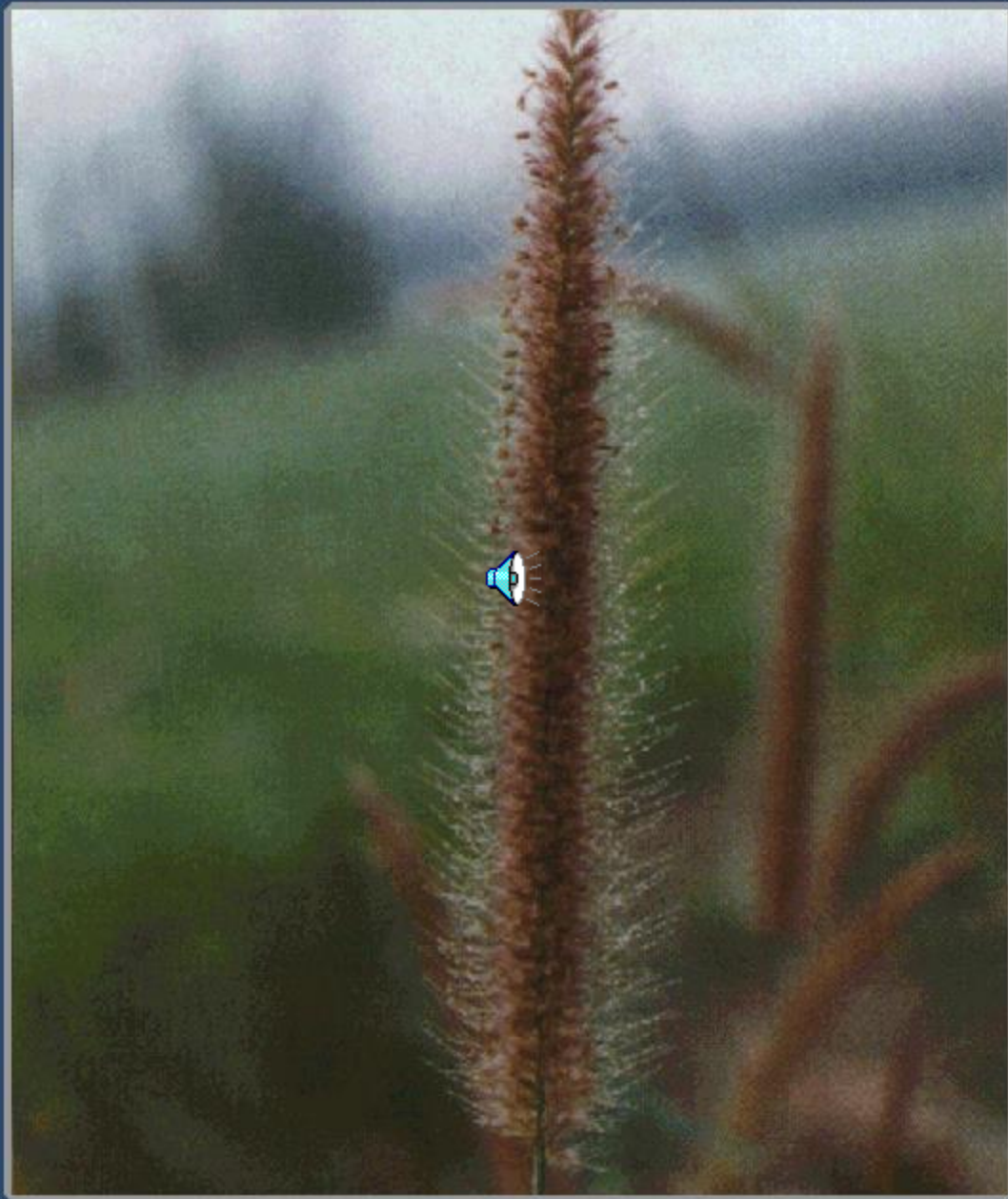
Awned spike.

Perennial erect grass. Resistant to drought and poor soil.

Annual and 2-2.5 m high erect. Spikes.
